

Tasmania statement Adoption of NatHERS software

Tasmania has deferred the adoption of the National Construction Code (NCC) 2022 Energy Efficiency Provisions.

The requirements for Class 1, Class 2 and Class 4 parts of a building will remain with the provisions detailed in NCC 2019.

NatHERS software that uses version 3.21 of the Chenath engine or newer is deemed suitable to meet the energy efficiency performance requirements of JPI – Volume 1, NCC 2019 and P2.6.1 – Volume 2, NCC 2019 applicable to these NCC building classifications.
